OTHER FUN ACTIVITIES PLANNED FOR YOU.....

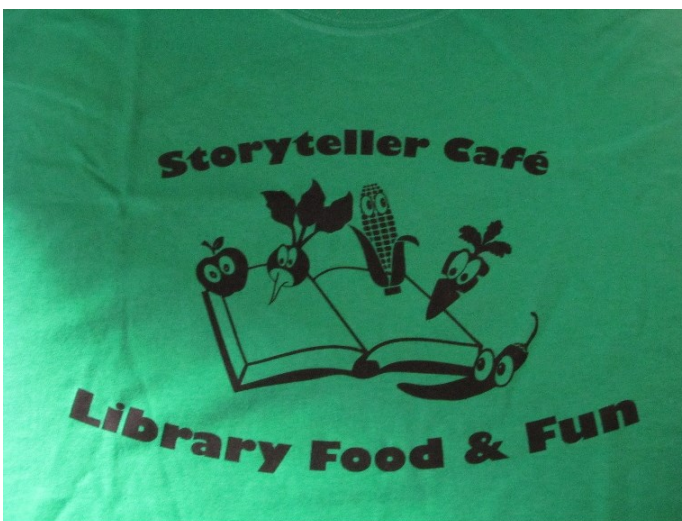
Monday morning math will be STEM activities for children ages 6 to 11 and will be held each Monday at 9 AM.

Encourage people to take part in the summer meals program at the Storyteller's Café. To make these worthwhile I need each and every one of you to help us promote these events. It is FREE entertainment, food, and learning for children of all ages and we need our community to take advantage of it. Adults are welcome to attend any or all of the programs.

This year we are self-funded and some of the previous rules do not apply. Adult mentors are invited to eat if they would like and all our food will be prepared onsite.
